All nominations MUST be received by the close of business on Thursday May 26th 2022. Nominations received after this date will be declared ineligible in accordance with section 14 of the NBCA constitution. Nominations will be considered by the Council at its AGM

to be held on Saturday June 18th, 2022.

Nominations should comply with the <u>NBCA's Constitution</u> and nominees should acquaint themselves with section 14 and section 17 which details the nomination requirements and duties of the position. <u>Details can be found here</u>.
