2023 VIC STATE SOLO & ENSEMBLE CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Victorian Bands' League warmly invites you to participate in the 2023 Victorian State Solo & Ensemble <u>Championships</u> to be held at Methodist Ladies College, Kew on Saturday July 29th.

Entries close Sunday May 28th with late entries still being accepted until Sunday June 4th. Please note that late entries will attract a late fee of 50% of the entry fee.

Sections are broken into Age Categories which are Under 10 Years, Under 12 Years, Juvenile, Junior, Open, and Senior. Some sections are for specific instruments while others require a certain type of piece to be player (e.g. Air & Variations, Popular Song) or composer (Australian Work) be chosen.

Where no specific requirements are given then you are free to perform any piece of music you wish. Ensemble sections require a certain number of performers to be performing together. Please see the 2023 Schedule for more information. A few items to note are below:

- There is no limit to the number of sections a competitor can enter however a different piece must be performed in each section.
- A competitor may only compete once in the duet/ trio section however may compete more than once in the Open and Junior Quartet/Quintet and Ensemble sections.
- The Slow/Sacred Melody section requires a piece that is purely melodic. The tempo generally will not exceed 80 crotchet beats per minute.
- The Australian work section requires a piece by an Australian composer
- The Popular Song section requires a piece that is instantly recognisable and was made popular in the last 70 years.
